Welcome/Introductions/Make-Up of SIC Meetings (Mr. Verburg)

Mr. Verburg welcomed members in attendance and called the meeting to order. All members introduced themselves and indicated their role as either student, parent, community member, or school faculty/administration.

Principal Update (Mr. Verburg)

Mr. Verburg provided an update for Mrs. Rawl. The football stadium is at full capacity. The baseball stadium is scheduled to be completed by December 18th. More test scores will be available on November 3rd and we are looking forward to good news. An update on the SAT scores for LHS compared to the state was provided.

FIT Update (Mr. Allison)

The balance in the fund is just over \$6,000 and 35 bags are packed per week. The pantry is full. A suggestion was made to ask people to drop off food in the front office. Mr. Verburg will discuss promoting food donations with Ashley Miller. A question was raised regarding an emergency plan for situations like the flood. This will be looked at for the future. SIC members are asked to donate peanut butter or jelly at the next meeting.

Good News Update (Mr. Verburg)

The football team is 8-1, first in the region, and has 2 players and 1 trainer in the Shrine Bowl.

SIC Goals (Mr. Verburg and Mrs. Wise)

#1 is the FIT Program. Mrs. Wise asked the students to develop a plan of their own to uplift students in need. Rosemary Farley suggested diversity week or opening a student dialogue that is initiated by students not adults. Jacob Vining suggested integrated students with special needs into the arts curriculum.

School Store (Mr. Verburg)

This is goal #2. Since the work schedule for the store is an issue, the on-line store will be the focus. Mr. Derrick was asked for ideas on how to run the platform. Students will be asked to take photos and these will be added to a link for the store on the school website. Discussions about calling the office and designing an order form were had. Mr. Verburg will talk to Ms. Carol to see if there is a volunteer from Booster Club who can fill the orders. It was suggested that the link could be added to the Wildcats website.

Staff Appreciation (Mrs. Wise)

This is goal @3. Each month there will be some type of staff appreciation/bonding. Each month will have a theme. December 2nd is collaborative planning and Mrs. Wise is soliciting business to help provide lunch for faculty and staff. SIC members were asked to help with the meal. The question was raised about communicating this with parents so they could help. Mr. Verburg will ask Mrs. Rawl. Sign-up Genius was mentioned as a resource. Coach Allison suggested students writing postcards to teachers in ILT.
