Welcome

Mr. Matt McCormack welcomed members in attendance and called the meeting to order.

Principal Update

Mrs. Rawl shared the following information. EOC exam scores were phenomenal. Two teachers are piloting the new teacher evaluation, which is 20% district choice. The smart snacks requirement allows for up to 13 fatty, high sugar snacks as fundraisers with approval. Dr. Woodward visited the school last week and talked to the student and parents about ILT. LHS will be on the same schedule next year. Dr. Woodward said to remind Mr. Butler about the LHS coffee shop. Mrs. Anna Duvall was named State Guidance Counselor of the Year. Mrs. Billue is a district finalist for Teacher of the Year. Edgenuity labs run during ILT time. This way, students can pick up credits to pass. This arrangement has saved 30 kids from failure. ACT can count towards college admission if a student wants it to. New track and tennis courts are finished and look great.

Transportation Information

Tim, Stepp, the Director of Transportation for Lexington One, presented information about the bus needs for the district and state. There is currently legislation for replenishing the buses so there are no buses older than 15 years, but this is dependent on funding being available. There are 200 SCDE buses in Lexington One and 135 are dilapidated. It was asked that information about how to contact state legislators be shared with parents. SIC members should communicate with colleagues and neighbors regarding the bus needs in SC.

FIT Update

Mr. McCormack gave an update on FIT. Thank you to SIC members for food donations. SIC can begin selling biscuits again and will do so once it warms up. There are currently no pressing needs

School Store

Mr. McCormack shared that Ms. Allison couldn't come tonight. He shared that there are dates where help with the school store is needed—February 11, 18, 25; March 11, 18, 25, and April 15, 22, 29, from 10:00-3:30. Mr. McCormack will send a Google Doc for SIC members to sign up to cover the store. The question was asked if SIC members need to fill out a volunteer form. Mr. McCormack will check. It was also asked if the school store could be put back into the announcements. A discussion about the need to sell at a variety of school events was had. Mr. McCormack will share information about the ability of the store to create and sell apparel for clubs, etc. with the department heads. Asking the Booster Club to get merchandise to sale for things such as chorus concerts, etc. was discussed. A mention was made of the Academic or Arts Booster Club that was discussed last year.

Information discussed at the Ambassadors' Meeting included changes in testing, new career readiness system, IB Program at Lexington Middle School, big changes in technology, and having a growth mindset.
