**Welcome**

Mr. Matt McCormack welcomed members in attendance and called the meeting to order.

**Principal Update**

School Board passed the next installment for expansion of field for standing area and replacing the trailer for the pressbox at the stadium and improvements to baseball stadium. Next will be the old locker rooms. There are 13 available slots for non-smart snacks and 4 have already been taken. Budget meetings went well. Furniture for inside of the school and updates to software and hardware were included. No decision has been made on AirMac or new iPads. Enrollment next year is projected at 1,780 students and two new positions will be gained (math and SS). Mrs. Rawl approved a request to have sign-outs permitted up to two-weeks in advance.

**SIC Goals**

Mr. McCormack reviewed the SIC goals. The first is FIT. The second is supporting the school store. The third is transportation.

**FIT Update**

Mr. McCormack shared an update from Ms. Goodson. FIT is currently serving 20 students. Lexington Church of Christ continues to contribute. Ashley Miller still shops for FIT. The balance in the fund is approximately \$7,000. The SIC agreed to do 1 Chick-Fil-A Biscuit Sale this spring.

Mr. McCormack will contact Cook Out to see about a 10% LHS night.

**Testing**

Dr. Walters asked Mr. McCormack to share a handout on the ACT. All students in 3<sup>rd</sup> year will take the ACT on 4/28/2015 and the ACT WorkKeys on 4/29/2-15. Students' ACT scores can be used when applying for college. Students' ability to graduate from high school is not affected by these scores. Information went home to parents.

Haidee Stith shared information about the last meeting. Information included Habits of Scholarship, grading students on time management and persistence, and the idea of growth mindset.
