Welcome

Mr. Matt McCormack welcomed members in attendance and called the meeting to order. SIC members introduced themselves.

Principal Update

Mrs. Rawl shared test score updates for 2013-2014 information.

SIC Officers for 2014-2015

Kathy Coskrey was elected Secretary. Wendy Gallagher was elected Vice-Chair. At the next meeting, the Chair will be elected.

FIT Update

Cocky Oswald gave an overview and update on the FIT (Food Improving Thinking) program. In the past, biscuits sales, donations, and grants have funded the program. Kathy Upton's church donates to the program. Teacher Tiffany Goodson has taken over the running of the program since Clyde Sanders retired. We have \$8000 in the account. Last year 30-40 students were served. 22 students are currently receiving backpacks on Fridays. Current needs include plastic bags, which Coach Stepp will handle; small (single serve) boxes of cereal; and as always, monetary funding.

Poverty Update

Mrs. Rawl shared information about playspend.com, an activity to see how long you can live if you lost your job. She did it with her teachers for staff development. Many high school students hide issues related to poverty. Last year at LHS, 18% of students received Free and Reduced Lunch.

Fundraising Update

Mr. McCormack shared information about changes to what can be sold for fundraising. Items that can be sold are ones that can't be readily eaten, like cookie dough. The State Board of Education is looking at a waiver. Currently items can be sold between 4:30 and midnight on school property that don't meet the healthy food requirements. SIC members suggested Mo's Night, Salsarita's Night, and Fatz's Night as possible future fundraisers. Cookout was also mentioned.

Academic Booster Club

Mrs. Rawl shared that the school received two checks this summer to use for academic competition. A check from Target was about \$2000.

School Store

From discussions by the SIC last year, Ms. Burgess and Mr. McCormack met with Allison Carroll and the school spirit store will open on October 1st. Students are voting on a name for the store. Currently Ms. Allison is manning the store and it is open on Wednesdays from 10am-4pm. Students may go during their Lex Flex time and parents may go at the end of the school day. SIC members toured the stores.

Building and Campus Renovations Update

Mrs. Rawl shared information on the building and campus renovations. The track and tennis courts are in progress and estimated to be completed by January 2015. The baseball stadium hasn't been started yet and unless the company can promise completion by February 1, 2015, the renovations won't start until after the 2015 baseball season. Next summer, the D Wing will become the new center and there will be a total renovation of the old gym area including locker rooms and storage. Some renovations like a café and school store may go to a bond referendum. MB Kahn has a 5 year plan.
