

# **Student Drivers and Parking at Lexington High School**

## **Parking on Campus**

All students must have a parking tag to park on campus. To park on campus students must:

1. Complete Alive at 25.
2. Complete consent forms for the Drug Testing Program.
3. Purchase a parking tag.

\*We will not allow temporary passes or allow you to park on campus without completing all parking requirement in advance.

## **Parking Tickets**

1. We expect every vehicle parked on our campus to have a parking tag displayed each day the vehicle is parked on campus.
2. If there is not a parking tag or you are parked in an unauthorized area, you will have a parking ticket placed on your car. You need to see Mr. Seddon with your parking ticket the next school day to take care of the situation. If you see Mr. Seddon the next school day, there will be a minimal consequence.
3. If you do not see Mr. Seddon the next school day, the copy of the parking ticket will be turned over to Officer Reed and he will run the tag on your vehicle. We will then call you to the office and you will receive the maximum consequence for parking on campus without a parking tag being displayed or for parking in an unauthorized area. It is in your best interest to see Mr. Seddon immediately to take care of a parking ticket.

## **Gravel Parking Lot**

During the spring semester, the gravel lot will be available only to spring sports athletes. If you are a member of a spring sports team that needs to park in the gravel parking lot during 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, please see your coach at the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester to get a sticker allowing you to park in the gravel lot.

## **Being in the Parking Lot During the School Day**

Any student found in the parking lots during regular school hours (8:20 to 3:25) without a pass from an administrator, with the exception of students walking to or from the Lexington Technology Center through the breezeway, will be in violation of Cutting/Leaving School. Students are not allowed to loiter in the parking lots or outside the school building during the school day including ILT. Students are not allowed in vehicles during school hours without permission from an administrator.
