Dear Parents and Students.

State law states that If your student has more than 5 unexcused absences (this includes parent notes) for a semester class or more than 3 unexcused absences for a 9 week class then they must do SEARS to get credit for the class. SEARS is a seat time recovery program offered by LHS that allows students to make up seat time if they have exceeded their allowed unexcused absences.
