Important Information:

1. In order to purchase tickets to the Prom a Lexington High School student must be classified as a Junior or Senior in PowerSchool.
2. If a Lexington High School student is interested in bringing a guest to the Prom:
 - a. A guest pass must be completed and approved prior to April 25, 2018.
 - b. Guests of students 21 years of age or older and students that are in the eighth grade or below, will not be considered for a guest pass.
3. All students that attend will be required to have a picture ID to enter the Prom.
4. Guest Pass Application will be available at the Lexington High School Main Office beginning Wednesday, March 7 (eight weeks before due date)
